## Counselor in Training (CIT) Program


Are you interested in becoming a summer camp counselor in the future? Do you enjoy working with children? Our Counselor in Training Program is your chance to learn what it takes to become a successful camp counselor! Completion of the CIT training will include certification in CPR & First Aid - an essential for camp counselors! The CIT Program consists of two training sessions. During the first training session, CITs will learn about our camp program and policies, learn developmentally appropriate activities to use with children, and will gain skills and knowledge, assisting them to better work with children. The second session is an in-camp training session in which CITs will be paired with experienced camp counselors and will put their new skills to the test in an actual camp setting.

Once the two training sessions have been successfully completed, CITs may apply for a paid CIT position for the duration of the summer camp sessions or may choose to volunteer their time assisting in camps. **Employment is not guaranteed through completion of the program.**


CIT participants must be 16-18 years of age by July 5, 2010. Application packets will be available at the Aviary Front Office. Please register at the same time of packet pick-up. Completed packets must be turned in to the Aviary Front Office prior to the beginning of the Training Session.
